#### 100 for Humboldt

Henry and Jane met with Jeff Gollner and Ryan Dix both with MCP. We jointly walk south from the pavilion and found ample opportunities for over 20 trees along the roadway to Oklahoma Ave.

Jeff was informed the remainder of the 100 tree program is fully funded. Jeff noted he will review possible spring and fall planting schedule to possibly complete the program this year. Jeff suggested investing some trees be planted along the crest the hill near the band shell. Henry will continue dialogue with Jeff on the tree's program including Tree Day. Tamarack availability from MCP nursery' source (8) at about 6' tall could be considered for the LaGrow memorial. Further discussion needed to best address the memorial consideration expectations.
